Applying Basic Health, Hygiene, Safety and Nutrition Practices for Children 0-8 years

1. Health related issues and concerns of children

3. Safety practices such as setting up safe environment and administering basic first aid to children
4. Nutritional needs of children

Must be able to assist children in such routines as feeding, bathing, playing and assist in lesson-preparation.
